The Sapporo Olympic Museum is located at the foot of the Okurayama Ski Jump Stadium. You can observe historical materials related to winter sports and experience various winter sports through interactive attractions, allowing you to feel the true excitement of winter sports.

The Okurayama Ski Jump Stadium, the venue for the ski jumping events at the 1972 Winter Olympics held in Sapporo, still hosts international competitions today. A chairlift brings you up to the top of the 307-meter-high mountain where you can enjoy a panoramic view of Sapporo city (*Extra fares required).

Shiroi Koibito Park is a theme park run by ISHIYA, a local confectionery manufacturer in Hokkaido. Shiroi Koibito, two thin plain cookies and a layer of white chocolate in between, is ISHIYA's flagship product and one of Hokkaido's most famous souvenirs. You can enjoy a souvenir shop, a cafe and a restaurant, and the paid area where you can observe the cookie production process with various chocolate-related exhibits.

Hokkaido Kaitaku-no Mura (Historical Village of Hokkaido) is an open-air museum established to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the founding of Hokkaido. The village preserves and displays historical buildings, showcasing the industries, lifestyle, and culture of Hokkaido's pioneering era. The village is divided into four areas: urban, rural, mountain, and fishing villages, allowing visitors to experience what Hokkaido was like over 100 years ago. During summer (mid-April to late November), visitors can also experience Japan's only horse-drawn railway (Extra fares required).

Kobayashi Shuzo (Kobayashi Sake Brewery), known for its sake brand “Kitano-Nishiki,” is the oldest sake brewery in Hokkaido founded in 1878 in Sapporo. The brewery relocated its base to Kuriyama in 1900 when the neighboring town Yubari was flourished as a coal-mining town. The site features several Western-style brick warehouses and Sapporo soft stone storerooms. Thirteen buildings, including the First to Sixth Sake Storages are registered as tangible cultural properties of Japan. You can explore the brewery while learning the history of sake brewing.
